**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – HARRISON/ROBERTS ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, LEATHERMAN PROPERTY, 11920 BALBOA BOULEVARD, GRANADA HILLS (NPDES CAG834001, CI-8630)**

In our letter dated August 26, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0125, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In your letter dated November 19, 2004, you informed Regional Board staff that the treatment system at the above-referenced facility was removed in October 2003. Therefore, you requested termination of your NPDES permit. On February 16, 2005, our staff inspected the facility, and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the project to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0125 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. If you have any questions, please contact Vilma Correa at (213) 576-6794.
