TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—MAYWOOD MUTUAL WATER CO. NO. 3, PLANT 3 WAREHOUSE WELL, 4809 E. 57TH STREET, MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-8657)

Dear Mr. Rohlf:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, Waste Discharge Requirements for *Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.


We have reviewed your March 8, 2010, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have not discharged any water from the well for the last 7 years and that the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed and, that the discharge from the subject facility to the San Gabriel River has been ceased.

On January 26, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the Los Angeles River. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005, for the facility is hereby terminated.


