D-1, RANCHO SANTA PAULA Y SATICOY PARCEL 25, NEAR LOS ANGELES AVENUE AND JACINTO WAY, SATICOY, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 03-189, CI-8692)

Dear Mr. Sehon:

Reference is made to the Notice of Termination dated November 12, 2004, requesting that we terminate your enrollment under the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality, Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ: Series No. 004, for discharges to land with a low threat to water quality. Regional Board staff inspected the site on June 9, 2005, and found the drill cuttings and other drilling debris had been removed and the surrounding area cleared. The Discharge Monitoring Program was implemented on January 9, 2004, and the required monitoring report was received on November 16, 2004.

Since there is no longer a discharge of well development water from the site, and all reporting requirements have been met, coverage under State Board Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ for the facility is hereby terminated.
