TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, HOLLYHILLS DRAIN UNIT 8B PHASE II PROJECT, ORLANDO AVENUE AND ROSEWOOD AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8738)

In our letter dated February 24, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In your letter dated February 25, 2008, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project has been completed. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES permit. On February 28, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters.

Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
