TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—GOLDEN STATE WATER COMPANY—TRURO PLANT WELL NO. 4 REHABILITATION PROJECT, 11305 TRURO AVENUE, INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-8757)

In our letter dated May 26, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your June 5, 2009, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you completed the subject project.

On June 17, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005, for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any groundwater to surface water become necessary at the site, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
