TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE (NPDES) PERMIT—CASTAIC LAKE WATER ELIMINATION SYSTEM TEMPORARY TREATMENT PLANT AT SAUGUS WELL NOS. 1 AND 2, MAGIC MOUNTAIN PARKWAY AT SOUTH FORK SANTA CLARA RIVER, SANTA CLARITA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-8798)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

We have reviewed your March 30, 2011, letter which requested termination of your coverage The letter indicated that you completed the well under the General NPDES Permit. development project and ceased the groundwater discharge to storm drain.

On February 17, 2012, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
