TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES PERMIT) – SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, MIDDLE RANCH WELL 6A, THOMPSON DAM, AVALON, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-8820)

In our letter dated November 2, 2004, we determined that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your letter dated May 5, 2005, informing the Regional Board that the aquifer testing at the above-mentioned facility has been completed. Therefore, the NPDES permit is no longer needed. Since there is no discharge, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
