**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – SAN GABRIEL VALLEY WATER COMPANY, PLANT NO. 2, 4921 KINGS ROW, EL MONTE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-8827)**

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General national Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your November 27, 2006, letter which requested termination of coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed construction of your Well No. 2F at Plant No. 2, and have ceased discharging groundwater from the subject facility to Rio Hondo Channel.

On January 25, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Rio Hondo Channel. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
