TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—VENTURA COUNTY GENERAL SERVICES AGENCY, OJAI MAINTENANCE YARD, 1768 MARICOPA HIGHWAY, OJAI, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI—8855)

Dear Mr. Hartzell:

In our letter dated September 3, 2010, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your May 16, 2011, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the groundwater cleanup project and that you have stopped the groundwater discharge to the storm drain.

On April 18, 2012, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
