COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, AGOURA ROAD MAINTENANCE YARD REMEDIATION PROJECT, 29773 WEST MULHOLLAND HIGHWAY, AGOURA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8866)

We have completed our review of your application for a permit to discharge waste under the NPDES. You have proposed to discharge up to 144,000 gallons per day of treated groundwater and rainwater that is ponded in the pit from the excavation of the former underground storage tank at the above-mentioned facility.

Based on the information provided, the proposed discharge of wastewater meets the conditions specified in Order No. R4-2003-0111; *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serves as your General NPDES permit, consisting of Order No. R4-2003-0111 and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) No. CI-8866. The discharge limitations in Part E.1.a. and c. of Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the specific constituents listed on the Table with the enclosed Fact Sheet are applicable to your discharge. The discharge from the site drains into Malibu Creek. Therefore, the discharge limitations in Attachment B.5.a. are also applicable to your discharge. Prior to starting discharge, a representative sample of the effluent must be obtained and analyzed to determine compliance with the discharge limitations.

The MRP requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring and technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8866 and NPDES No. CAG994004", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
