**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – BEVERLY HILLS SAN YSIDRO ASSOCIATE, SAN YSIDRO PROJECT, 1156 SAN YSIDRO DRIVE, BEVERLY HILLS (NPDES CAG994004, CI-8871)**

In our letter dated March 4, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On November 2, 2005, you informed Regional Board staff that you have not discharged groundwater from the above-referenced project since November 2005. Therefore, the NPDES permit is no longer necessary and you requested termination of your coverage under the above-reference General NPDES permit. On December 2, 2005, our staff inspected the facility, and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. If you have any questions, please contact Vilma Correa at (213) 576-6794.
