CORRECTION OF TYPOGRAPHIC ERRORS IN THE PERMITTING DOCUMENTS FOR COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – AVALONBAY COMMUNITIES, INC., AVALONBAY WILSHIRE PROJECT, 5115 WILSHIRE BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8893)

On May 25, 2005, we transmitted the above-referenced permit and approved your enrollment under the general NPDES permit. It has been brought to our attention that we inadvertently used an incorrect CI number (CI-8892) in the approval letter, Fact Sheet, and Monitoring and Reporting Plan. The correct CI number for your case is 8893. We have corrected the permitting documents and we are sending a corrected copy in the attachments of this letter. Please replace the original permitting documents in our May 25, 2005, transmittal with the corrected documents. We regret any inconvenience that this may have caused you.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serve as your NPDES permit, consisting of Order No. R4-2003-0111 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8893. The discharge limitations in Part E.1.a. of Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the specific constituents listed on the Table with the enclosed Fact Sheet are applicable to your discharge. The groundwater discharge flows into Ballona Creek. Therefore, discharge limitations in Attachment B of Order No. R4-2003-0111 are not applicable to your discharge.

The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8893 and NPDES No. CAG994004", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

In order to avoid future annual fees, please submit written notification when the project has been completed and the permit is no longer needed.
