COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CERRO METAL PRODUCTS COMPANY, FORMER FACILITY GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION PROJECT, 14900 GARFIELD AVENUE, PARAMOUNT, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG914001, CI-8902)

Dear Mr. St. Philip:

We have completed our review of your application for a permit to discharge waste under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). You have proposed to discharge up to 72,000 gallons per day of treated groundwater from the above-referenced project.

Based on the information provided, the proposed discharge of treated groundwater meets the conditions to be regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0107, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater From Investigation and/or Cleanup of Volatile Organic Compounds Contaminated-Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on May 23, 2002.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serve as your General NPDES Permit, consisting of Order No. R4-2002-0107 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8902. The discharge limitations in Part F.1. of Order No. R4-2002-0107 are applicable to your discharge. The groundwater discharge flows to the Los Angeles River between Figueroa Street and Los Angeles River Estuary (Willow Street). Therefore, the discharge limitations listed in Attachment B.7.d. are also applicable to your discharge.

The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8902 and NPDES No. CAG914001", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

In order to avoid future annual fees, please submit written notification when the project has been completed and the permit is no longer needed.
