**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
– 76 SERVICE STATION NO. 5836, 11305 CULVER BOULEVARD, CULVER CITY,  
CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, CI-8920, SERIES NO. 016)  
UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) CASE NO. R-24976 (PRIORITY D-1, EAOP)**

Dear Mr. Mosconi:

In our letter dated June 29, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2005-0030, Series No. 016, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 12, 2009, you notified the Regional Board that injection of ozone for remediation of petroleum hydrocarbons and fuel oxygenates at the site will be completed by June 30, 2009, and that you requested termination of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. Since you have ceased the ozone injection as of today and you no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, Series No. 016 for the subject facility is hereby terminated as of June 30, 2009. Please note that you would be required to re-apply for a WDR for future in-situ remedial activities, if any, for the subject site. Semi-annual groundwater monitoring requirements identified in our letter dated June 15, 2009 remain in effect.
