TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT SANTA MONICA MUNICIPAL BUS MAINTENANCE FACILITY, 1620 SIXTH STREET, SANTA MONICA, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES NO. 027, CI-8960)

Dear Mr. Velez-Conway:


In our letter dated September 26, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2005-0030 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated November 2, 2011, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased ozone injection for this site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since the City of Santa Monica has no plans to operate ozone sparging system in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
