
Dear Mr. Jones:

On December 31, 2008, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed subsurface injection of materials under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2007-0019. The authorized discharge was part of an approved *Work Plan for Implementation of Full-Scale In-Situ Chemical Oxidation in the Former Paraplast Area* for groundwater remediation of volatile organic compounds at the subject site.

On June 18, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of potassium permanganate was completed in September 2016 and no additional injection activities are planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2007-0019 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
