TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF LA VERNE, GROUNDWATER TREATMENT PLANT START-UP OPERATION PROJECT, 2898 AMHERST STREET, LA VERNE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-9073)

In our letter dated May 4, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by the Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your June 16, 2008 letter, requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the above-referenced project and the subject general permit is no longer needed.

On June 25, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994001, for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
