

TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—BUS CANYON TRIBUTARY-STORM DRAIN REPLACEMENT AND EXPANSION PROJECT, 1243 ARCANE STREET, SIMI VALLEY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9137)

Dear Mr. LeBlanc:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-01-11, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

We have reviewed your October 16, 2008, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed your storm drain expansion project at the above-referenced site and that the groundwater discharge from the subject site to the Arroyo Simi has been ceased.

On April 24, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Arroyo Simi. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
