TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS - JUNIPERO BEACH NEAR BLUFF PARK, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 06-166, CI-9148)

Dear Mr. Leung:

Our letter dated August 15, 2006 issued *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General WDRs, Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ) to the Long Beach Water Department for the discharge of wastewater generated during a proposed aquifer test on Junipero Beach near Bluff Park, Long Beach, California. The aquifer test started on October 23, 2007. On November 20, 2007, you submitted a Notice of Termination to the Regional Board indicating that the aquifer test had been completed and requesting us to terminate coverage of the General WDRs.

We have reviewed our records, including the chemical analytical data of two samples taken from the wastewater on October 25 and 27, 2007, respectively, and determined that the discharge of wastewater was in compliance with the General WDRs. In as much as the aquifer test has been completed, coverage of the general WDRs for the project is no longer required and hereby terminated.
