TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – FORMER EXXONMOBIL STATION 18-LDM LOCATED AT 12054 WILSHIRE BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES NO. 062, CI-9200)

Dear Mr. Hanley:

In our letter dated November 6, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2005-0030, Series No. 062, which also serves as your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

By letter dated March 24, 2008, you notified the Regional Board that in-situ chemical oxidation of total petroleum hydrocarbons performed for the site is complete and that you request rescission of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in the "WDR for In-situ Chemical Oxidation Second Quarter 2008 Report," dated July 15, 2008. Since the in-situ chemical oxidation has been completed, and the WDR is no longer needed, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, Series No. 062 for the subject facility is hereby terminated.
