TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—ONE WORLD TRADE CENTER., SUITE 198, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9201)

Dear Mr. McCullough:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.

We have reviewed your December 11, 2009, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have obtained a permit from the City of Long Beach to discharge groundwater from your facility to sanitary sewer system and that the discharge from the subject facility to the Los Angeles River Estuary has been ceased.

On January 26, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the Los Angeles River Estuary. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated.


