COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CALLEGUAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT – REGIONAL SALINITY MANAGEMENT PIPELINE (BRINE LINE), PHASE 1C - HYDROSTATIC TEST PROJECT, HUENEME ROAD BETWEEN ARNOLD ROAD AND EDISION DRIVE, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-9209)

We have completed our review of your application for a permit to discharge waste under the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). You propose to discharge approximately 374,000 gallons per day (GPD) of hydrostatic test water from the above-referenced project.

Based on the attached Fact Sheet and other information provided, the proposed discharge meets the conditions to be regulated under General Permit No. CAG674001, Order No. R4-2004-0109, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties (General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001)*, adopted by this Board on July 1, 2004.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serve as your General NPDES Permit, consisting of Order No. R4-2004-0109 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-9209. The discharge limitations in Section E Order No. R4-2004-0109 are applicable to your discharge. Discharge from the project drains to the Oxnard Industrial Storm Drain thence to Pacific Ocean. Therefore, the discharge limitations in Attachment B are not applicable to your discharge.

The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under Order No. R4-2004-0109. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-9209 and NPDES No. CAG674001", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

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
