TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—F & R FUEL, FORMER SEVLIAN TEXACO SERVICE STATION, 6954 ATLANTIC AVENUE, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-9301)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0021, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on April 5, 2007.


We have reviewed a letter from your consultant, Mr. Larry Witwer of Ami Adini & Associates, Inc., dated May 24, 2012, requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that discharge at the above-referenced project site has stopped and that the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed.

On May 31, 2012, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to surface water. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order R4-2007-0021, General NPDES Permit No. CAG834001, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
