TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—EDCO STATIONS, INC.—CARSON MINI TRUCK STOP REMEDIATION PROJECT, 101 WEST VICTORIA STREET, CARSON, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9347)

Dear Mr. Almoradi:

In our letter dated July 31, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On June 1, 2012, your consultant (Ami Adini & Associates, Inc.) informed Regional Board staff that dual-phase extraction remediation activities were completed in April 2011 and indicated that no groundwater discharge occurred from the above-referenced project since April 2011. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, your consultant requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On June 8, 2012, staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032 for the subject facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
