
Dear Ms. Daniels:

In our letter dated March 4, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated November 16, 2011, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the City of Oxnard does not intend to inject oxygen release compound into the groundwater in the future. Therefore, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
