TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—LONG BEACH WATER DEPARTMENT, NORTH LONG BEACH NO. 9 AND NO. 11 WATER WELLS, 1330 E. JACKSON STREET, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-9384)


In our letter dated May 8, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your June 10, 2009, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit because you have stopped your discharge. On June 24, 2009, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters from the project site.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order R4-2003-0108 for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs).

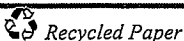

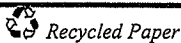
