**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE  
REQUIREMENTS 76 STATION NO. 3574  
4965 EAST FLORENCE AVENUE, BELL, CALIFORNIA (B-1 SITE), (UST FILE NO. I-11003)  
(ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 055, CI-9406)**

Dear Ms. London:

In our letter dated May 14, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, Series No. 055, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 12, 2009, you notified the Regional Board that ozone injection for groundwater cleanup of total petroleum hydrocarbons performed for the site will cease on June 30, 2009 and that you requested termination of the WDR. You further plan to prepare a remedial action plan to switch from ozone to air injection at the site.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. We have reviewed the data and concur with your plan to terminate the WDR. Since you plan to cease the injection of ozone into groundwater and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0019, Series No. 055 for the subject facility is hereby terminated effective on June 30, 2009.
