**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE  
REQUIREMENTS – UNOCAL SERVICE STATION NO. 2474, 11000 SOUTH ATLANTIC  
AVENUE, LYNWOOD, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 059, CI-9412)**

Dear Mr. Harris:

In our letter dated June 6, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, (Series No. 059), which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 18, 2009, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased ozone injection and requested termination of the WDR. You started injection of oxygen amended air which do not require WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. Since you have completed the ozone injection and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, (Series No. 059), for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.


