TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS PARAMOUNT STUDIOS 5555 MELROSE AVENUE, HOLLYWOOD, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES NO. 068, CI-9434) UST FILE I.D. No. 900380052

Dear Ms. Richards:

In our letter dated July 16, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2005-0030, Series No. 068, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 25, 2009, you notified the Regional Board that injection of chemical oxidant for groundwater cleanup at the site is completed and that you requested termination of the WDR. You further plan to prepare an alternative measure to clean up the residual groundwater contamination at the site.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. We have reviewed the data and concur with your plan to terminate the WDR. Since you plan to cease the injection of chemical oxidant into groundwater and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, Series No. 068 for the subject facility is hereby terminated effective on June 30, 2009. Please note that you may be required to re-apply for a WDR for future in-situ remedial activities for the subject site.
