TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CITY OF PARAMOUNT, WELL NO. 15, SOMERSET BLVD. & SAN ANTONIO AVE., PARAMOUNT, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-9457)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

In order to provide a statewide consistent regulation to all low-threat-type discharges from community water systems, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) has adopted the Statewide National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Drinking Water System Discharges to Waters of the United States (Order WQ 2014-0194-DWQ, General Order No. CAG140001) (State General Drinking Water Permit) on November 18, 2014. The State Water Board has issued a Notice of Applicability under the State General Drinking Water Permit on November 3, 2015 for the subject facility. Therefore, coverage under the Regional Water Board Order R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005 for the facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
