TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS— CEDARS-SINAI MEDICAL CENTER, ADVANCED HEALTH SCIENCES PAVILION PROJECT, 127 S. SAN VICENTE BLVD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9461)

Dear Mr. Kennedy:

In our letter dated October 30, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On February 17, 2012, Cedars-Sinai Medical Center (CSMC) informed the Regional Board that groundwater pumping was discontinued on October 31, 2011 and CSMC has concluded all discharges related to the subject project. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, CSMC requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On July 15, 2013, Regional Board staff inspected the subject project and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface water. Therefore, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032 for the subject project is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
