TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CITY OF LONG BEACH, CHITTICK FIELD PARK, 1800 N. WALNUT AVENUE, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9487)

Dear Ms. Gates:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.


We have reviewed your June 18, 2012, email requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. Your email indicated that the City of Long Beach has cancelled the proposed project to construct a sports and community center at Chittick Field Park. Therefore, the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed.

On August 29, 2012, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to surface water. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the proposed facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
