**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—COUNTY OF VENTURA, TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT—SOUTH MOUNTAIN ROAD BRIDGE, COUNTY BRIDGE NO. 448, SANTA PAULA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9499)**

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.

We have reviewed your May 10, 2010, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the construction project and that the groundwater discharge from the subject facility has been ceased. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated.


