TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – UNITED TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION CANOGA AVENUE FACILITY (FORMER PRATT & WHITNEY AND BOEING CANOGA AVENUE FACILITY), 6633 CANOGA AVENUE, CANOGA PARK, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 83-008, CI-9535, ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 100, GLOBAL ID WDR100000954)

Dear Mr. Curnock:

On August 31, 2009, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated December 23, 2013, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased injection of Hydrogen Release Compound-Advanced (HRC-A) at the subject site and requested termination of the WDR.

Since United Technologies Corporation has no plan to inject HRC-A in the future, the coverage for the subject facility under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 is hereby terminated, with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
