TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT OXNARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE – MAINTENACE BUILDING, 4000 ROSE AVENUE, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (WDR ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019-114, CI NO. 9553)

Dear Mr. Deits:

In our letter dated November 18, 2009, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated March 23, 2011, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased magnesium peroxide injection for this site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Because the ongoing remediation does not plan to continue to inject magnesium peroxide, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
