NON-IRRIGATION GENERAL WATER REUSE ORDER NO. R4-2009-0049 USED FOR STREET SWEEPING AND SANITARY SEWER FLUSHING — CITY OF LONG BEACH, (CI-9561)

Dear Mr. Harding:

Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) staff have completed our review of your Notice of Intent (NOI) form dated August 28, 2009. The City of Long Beach proposes to use tertiary-treated wastewater, currently regulated under NPDES Permit No. CA0054119 (Order No. R4-2007-0047) adopted by this Board on September 6, 2007, as recycled water for street sweeping and sanitary sewer flushing.

Based on the attached Fact Sheet and other information provided, we have determined that the proposed reuse at the above-referenced site meets the conditions to be regulated under Order No. R4-2009-0049, *Non-Irrigation General Water Reuse Order No. R4-2009-0049*, adopted by this Regional Board on April 2, 2009.

Enclosed are your general Waste Discharge Requirements and Water Recycling Requirements, consisting of Order No. R4-2009-0049, Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-9561 and Attachments A, B, E and W. The discharge limitations in Section B of Order No. R4-2009-0049 and the enclosed Fact Sheet are applicable to your discharge.

The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-9561 and Order No. R4-2009-0049", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

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
