TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMER SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON ORMOND BEACH GENERATING STATION, 6635 SOUTH EDISON DRIVE, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA 93033 (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, CI-9567, FILE NO. 09-185, SERIES NO. 115, GLOBAL ID WDR10000794)

Dear Mr. Weidner:

On December 30, 2009, Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the injection of extracted groundwater that has been treated by a two-stage granulated activated carbon (GAC) treatment system is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated December 10, 2014, you requested termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the injection of treated groundwater at the subject site was ceased at the end of October 2013 and the water treatment system was removed in June 2014. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
