TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF OXNARD, RICE AVENUE INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS—ROUTE 101 POST MILE 19.4 TO POST MILE 20.6/RICE AVENUE, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI—9590)

Dear Mr. Roshanian:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.

We have reviewed you November 13, 2012, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that construction project was completed and the permit is no longer needed. On March 6, 2013, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, CI-9590 for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
