TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER (LADWP), HARBOR REFINERY WATER RECYCLING PROJECT, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI—9605)

Dear Ms. Rubin:

The subject discharges are regulated under Order No. R4-2009-0068, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties (General NPDES Permit)*, adopted by this Board on June 4, 2009.

We have reviewed your March 14, 2019, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that, on December 23, 2016, LADWP obtained coverage under the Statewide General NPDES Permit, Drinking Water Systems Order No. WQ 2014-0194-DWQ for potable water system discharges from your facility that include hydrostatic test water discharges. Therefore, the General NPDES permit is no longer necessary and is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
