TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AT PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON FUEL, VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUND AND/OR HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM IMPACTED SITES – CANNERS STEAM COMPANY, 249 CANNERY STREET, SAN PEDRO, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 10-146, ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 160, CI-9634, GLOBAL ID. WDR100000193)

Dear Mr. Cannon:

On October 20, 2010, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed subsurface injection of materials under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2007-0019. The authorized discharge was part of an approved *Proposed Additional Groundwater Remediation Activities* for groundwater remediation of volatile organic compounds and total petroleum hydrocarbons at the Cannery Steam Company.

On July 1, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of Oxygen Release Compound was completed in July 2014 and no additional injection activities are planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2007-0019 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. However, the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department will be required to submit a Report of Waste Discharge for discharges associated with further groundwater remediation should the Site Cleanup Unit staff determine it appropriate based on additional groundwater monitoring results to be conducted.
