**TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT U.S. POSTAL SERVICE, 5823 WHITE OAK AVENUE, ENCINO, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 149, CI-9661, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100000594)**

Dear Ms. Andrews:

On February 9, 2011 this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated July 31, 2012, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased injection of Fenton's reagent (RegenOx) and oxygen release compound (ORC) at the subject site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since United States Postal Service has no plan to inject Fenton's reagent (RegenOx) and ORC in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
