TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—VENTURA COUNTY WATERSHED PROTECTION DISTRICT—JEPSON WASH DEBRIS BASIN SPILLWAY RETROFIT PROJECT, BETWEEN OAK AND GRAND AVENUE, FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI—9680)

Dear Mr. Norman:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.

We have reviewed your June 30, 2011, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the construction dewatering project and that you have stopped the groundwater discharge to the wash.


As indicated to you in our August 2, 2011, correspondence Regional Board staff has conducted and completed the compliance history review for your facility. Based on the review, no outstanding mandatory minimum penalty violations exist for your facility. Therefore, your permit has been cleared for termination.

On November 22, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005, for the facility is hereby terminated.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
