TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT CATALINA CRUISE TERMINAL, 1510 SWINFORD STREET, SAN PEDRO, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 12-004, ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 188, CI-9819, GLOBAL ID. WDR100002172)

Dear Mr. Carrier:

On May 7, 2012, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated June 7, 2012, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the application of activated persulfate in the remedial excavation areas will not proceed due to its corrosion potential. Therefore, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
