**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR DISCHARGES OF AQUATIC PESTICIDES TO WATERS OF THE UNITED STATES, (CI-9821, NPDES CAG990005)—AQUATECHNEX, LLC**


The subject general NPDES Permit coverage was authorized under Order No. 2004-0009-DWQ, *Statewide General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit For the Discharge of Aquatic Pesticides for Aquatic Weed Control in Waters of the United States*.

In an email dated November 19, 2013, you requested termination of the subject permit coverage because Self Realization Fellowship Lake Shrine where your company was contracted to apply aquatic pesticides, is no longer using aquatic pesticides for algae control.

Since the discharges covered under NPDES No. CAG990005 has ceased, coverage under Board Order No. 2004-0009-DWQ for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
