
Dear Mr. Metcalf:

On March 25, 2013, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the in-situ chemical oxidation (ISCO) and enhanced in-situ bioremediation (EISB) pilot tests for groundwater remediation are regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated November 7, 2016, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because ISCO and EISB injection activities were never initiated at the site. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
