TERMINATION OF STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SABLE RANCH, 25975 SAND CANYON ROAD, CANYON COUNTRY, LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 12-149, ORDER NO. 2003-0003-DWQ, SERIES NO. 016, CI-9937, GLOBAL ID WDR100009767)

Dear Mr. Wehrenberg:

On March 14, 2014, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) Water Quality Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

On May 25, 2016, you requested termination of the WDR coverage under State Board Water Quality Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ because the last day of operation was April 25, 2014. Since then, there was no further discharge of wastewater to the percolation pond and all activities associated with the WDR were terminated.

The subject property is now vacant. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject property, under State Board Water Quality Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
