Project: Upper Santa Clara River Arundo/Tamarisk Removal Plan (SCARP) - Site Specific Project

Proponent: City of Santa Clarita

Description: The Upper Santa Clara River Watershed Arundo/Tamarisk Removal Plan (SCARP) was developed by the Ventura County Resource Conservation District (VCRCD), under a Proposition 13 grant. The primary objective of SCARP is to guide and facilitate the implementation of invasive plant removal projects within the upper Santa Clara River watershed of Los Angeles County. There are three elements associated with the SCARP effort: The Long Term Implementation Plan, the Programmatic Environmental Impact Report/Permitting, and the City of Santa Clarita Site Specific Plan (hereafter referred to as Site Specific Project).

Specific to this SEP, the City is requesting funding for the demonstration project to fully implement the Site Specific Project. The Site Specific Project would result in removal of noxious and invasive plants from a highly visible 297-acre area of the river located in, and owned by, the City of Santa Clarita; act as a low impact arundo and tamarisk removal demonstration project for interested agencies, landowners, and non-profits; and stimulate public interest in, and support for, such removal projects.
