Chair Camacho asked Board members for any non-Santa Susana Field Lab (SSFL) ex parte communications.

There were no non-SSFL communications reported by the Board members.

**Board Member Méndez** reported on the following: On Tuesday, October 17, 2023, the National Academies of Sciences Engineering and Medicine released a new report on the decarbonization of the energy sector. He was one of the 23 coauthors on the report. The report includes discussion on water and land use and centers on issues of justice and equity in the decarbonization process.

# Item 6 - Executive Officer's Report

Susana Arredondo, Executive Officer, provided updates of the following items:

- 1) Update on the former Waymire Drum Company site in the Florence-Firestone area of the unincorporated area south of downtown Los Angeles.
  - a. On October 4, 2023, the Regional Board staff met with staffers with the Office Representative Robert Garcia of the 42nd Congressional District of California. Regional Water Board staff briefed the representative's office on the site history, ongoing assessment, cleanup activities, and on our attempts to secure funding and possible future regulatory activities.
  - b. On October 20, 2023, Regional Water Board staff will hold a meeting with representatives of East Yard Communities for Environmental Justice and Juntos Florence-Firestone to provide updates on ongoing activities at the site.
- 2) Hispanic Servicing Institutions Virtual Career Expo. On October 12, 2023, the State Water Board Resource Control Board's Talent Acquisition Unit invited Regional Water Board staff to the Hispanic Servicing Institution's (HSI) Virtual Career Expo. The expo is a collaborative partnership between 14 of the leading HSI in the country with at least 51% Hispanic student population. The Regional Water Board offered a workshop that introduced students to agency programs and the opportunity to ask questions about the agency.

Chair Camacho opened the floor for Board member questions.

Board Member Méndez asked one question. The Executive Officer, Susana Arredondo responded to his question.

#### *Item 7 – Update from State Water Board* [Board Member Laurel Firestone]

The State Water Board Liaison provided an update of the following items:

- 1) Update on the annual Water Quality Coordinating Committee (WQCC). The WQCC meeting will be held on Monday and Tuesday, October 23 and 24, 2023 at headquarters.
- Update on the one-year anniversary of the release of the Governor's office water supply strategy.

- 3) On October 4, 2023, was the first public hearing on Making Conservation a Way of Life Water Use Efficiency. Public comments will be open until October 17, 2023.
- 4) On September 28, 2023, an update on the public process for Bay-Delta Plan was released.
- 5) 5) On October 3, 2023, the State Water Board extended the Water and Wastewater Arrearage Payment Program.

Chair Camacho opened the floor for Board members' questions.

Chair Camacho: Announced agenda Item 12

Item 12 – Consideration of Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and NPDES Permit Renewal for The Boeing Company, Santa Susana Field Laboratory, Canoga Park, CA. This item is a continuation of Item 9 from Thursday, September 28, 2023, which was devoted to the staff presentation and public comment. This item will continue public comments, limited to those persons identified during the September 28, 2023, meeting who were unable to present their comments at that time, and includes staff and board discussion.

Chair Camacho made an opening statement for the continuation of the hearing. She first addressed a procedural matter. On October 17th, Boeing submitted a letter seeking to admit a large volume of documents into the administrative record for this proceeding. Chair Camacho declined to admit the letter or associated documents into the record, except to the extent that they were already in the record, because Boeing's letter was untimely. Chair Camacho ruled that admission of the letter and the associated documents into the record would prejudice the Board and the other Parties. Chair Camacho then explained the order of proceedings and asked the Board members if they had any questions about the proceedings.

There were no questions from the Board members.

Chair Camacho asked Board members if they had any new ex parte disclosures related to SSFL.

Chair Camacho reported on one communication.

She read the PEER comments in The Guardian article and the Thousand Oaks Acorn article related to SSFL.

Vice Chair Nahai and Board Members Christiansen and Méndez reported they did not read the articles mentioned by Chair Camacho.

Chair Camacho administered the oath and then began with the first presentation.
