1	On page 2-34, the EWMP incorrectly states that the JWPCP discharges to Santa Monica Bay when in fact the outfalls discharge to the south of the Palos Verdes Peninsula. Therefore, in the second to the last paragraph, please change the sentence to read as follows:	Revised.
	"In addition, from 1947 to 1971 large quantities of DDT were discharged from the Montrose Chemical plant in Los Angeles, which manufactured DDT, to the Los Angeles County Joint Water Pollution Control Plant (JWPCP) and discharges into the Santa Monica Bay to the coastal waters of the Palos Verdes Shelf."
