ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STATE ROUTE 70 FROM YUBA PM 25.5/25.8 AND BUTTE PM 0.0/4.0 (03-3H930) PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A04CR00314A1), BUTTE AND YUBA COUNTIES

This Order responds to the 2 October 2020 request for an amendment of the State Route 70 from Yuba PM 25.5/25.8 and Butte PM 0.0/4.0 (03-3H930) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID No. 5A04CR00314). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 21 July 2020. The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

California Department of Transportation, District 3 is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order to change the required compensatory mitigation from Bullock Bend Mitigation Bank to a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved mitigation bank or in-lieu fee program or another mechanism approved by the Central Valley Water Board. Therefore, Section XIV.K.2; Section XIV, Table 4; and Attachment B, Table 4 and Table 5 are amended. Table 5 has been added to Section XIV and Table 6 has been added to Attachment B in underline format below.

XIV.K Compensatory Mitigation for Permanent impacts:

2. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation

a. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 1.91 acres of stream channel by purchasing 1.91 stream channel credits from a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved mitigation bank or 3.82 aquatic resource credits from a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved In-Lieu Fee Program.

- **b.** The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.09 acre of wetlands by purchasing 0.09 <u>wetland</u> <u>credits from a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved mitigation bank or 0.18 aquatic resource credits from a United States Army Corps of Engineers approved In-Lieu Fee Program.</u>
- **c.** Total required Project compensatory mitigation information for permanent physical loss of area is summarized in Table 4 <u>and/or Table 5</u>. [Establishment (Est.), Re-establishment (Re-est.), Rehabilitation (Reh.), Enhancement (Enh.), Preservation (Pres.), Unknown].
